Implementation of Programme and Budget Committee conclusion 2005/3

Report of the Chairperson, Programme and Budget Committee

1. At its twenty-first session, the Programme and Budget Committee adopted conclusion 2005/3, in which it invited the Chair to conduct open-ended informal consultations in order to give clear guidance to the Secretariat on the proposed programme and budgets, 2006-2007, before the thirtieth session of the Industrial Development Board. In the same conclusion, the Committee invited the Secretariat to provide Member States with adjustments, if necessary, to document IDB.30/6-PBC.21/6.

2. Taking into account the interventions of delegations during the twenty-first session of the Committee, informal consultations were conducted at various levels during the period following the session. Meetings of the Enlarged Bureau of the Committee on 10 and 17 June 2005 discussed two working papers, as shown in the annexes to the present document. As of 17 June 2005, consultations were still ongoing. Any further developments will be reported orally to the Board.
