SUMMARY OF MEETINGS

MONDAY, 20 June 2005

1st PLENARY MEETING

The thirtieth session of the Industrial Development Board was opened by the outgoing President, H.E. Mr. O. Zniber (Morocco), who made a statement.

Item 3: Annual Report of the Director-General for 2004

Statements were made by the representatives of Indonesia (on behalf of the G77 and China), Luxembourg (on behalf of the European Union, the acceding countries Bulgaria and Romania, the candidate countries Croatia and Turkey as well as the countries of the Stabilization and Association Process and potential candidates Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, The Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Serbia and Montenegro and the EFTA country Norway, member of the European Economic Area as well as Ukraine), Pakistan (on behalf of the Asian Group), Egypt (on behalf of the African Group), Japan, Colombia, Russian Federation, and India; and the observer from Georgia (on behalf of GUAM countries, Georgia, Ukraine, Azerbaijan, and Republic of Moldova).
