3rd PLENARY MEETING

Item 14: Recommendation of a candidate for the post of the Director-General.

Statements were made by the representatives of Egypt (on behalf of the African Group), Kenya and Nigeria, and by observers from Uganda and the African Union.

The public meeting was adjourned, after which a private meeting took place.

The Board resumed its public meeting and the President announced that the Board has recommended Mr. K.Yumkella (Sierra Leone) for the post of the Director-General and adopted two decisions.
