## 10 a.m. 7<sup>th</sup> Plenary meeting

Item 5: Credentials of representatives to the Conference

The Chairman of the Credentials Committee presented his report. Statements were made by the representatives of Kenya and Nigeria.

Item 10 (b): Restoration of voting rights

The representative of Kazakhstan made a statement. The Conference decided to restore the voting rights for Afghanistan and Kazakhstan.

Item 10 (e): Appointment of an External Auditor

Statements were made by the representatives of the Philippines, Ethiopia (on behalf of the African Group) and China.

The Conference appointed Mr. Shauket Fakie, Auditor General of the Republic of South Africa, as the External Auditor of UNIDO for the period 2006-2008.

Statements were made by the representatives of Nigeria (on behalf of the African Group), the Philippines and South Africa.

## 3 p.m. 8<sup>th</sup> Plenary meeting

Honorary Goodwill Ambassador ceremony A statement was made by Goodwill Ambassador Blanco Villegas (Argentina).

The Conference appointed Mr. Enrique Iglesias (Uruguay) as Honorary Goodwill Ambassador to UNIDO.

The Director-General made a statement. Statements were made by the representatives of Uruguay, Bolivia and Mexico.
