Scale of assessments for the fiscal period 2010-2011

Note by the Secretariat

Proposes a scale of assessments for the fiscal period 2010-2011, based on the latest available United Nations scale adopted in resolution 61/237 by the United Nations General Assembly, adjusted to the membership of UNIDO.

I. Scale of assessments

1. The Programme and Budget Committee is required under Article 10.4 of the Constitution to prepare the draft scale of assessments for regular budget expenditures, for submission to the Board. In accordance with Article 15.1 of the Constitution of UNIDO "Regular budget expenditures shall be borne by the Members, as apportioned in accordance with a scale of assessment established by the Conference by a two-thirds majority of the Members present and voting, upon the recommendation of the Board adopted by a two-thirds majority of the Members present and voting, on the basis of a draft prepared by the Programme and Budget Committee."

2. Article 15.2 states that "The scale of assessments shall be based to the extent possible on the scale most recently employed by the United Nations. No Member shall be assessed more than twenty-five per cent of the regular budget of the Organization." The General Conference at its ninth session adopted decision GC.9/Dec.10, in which it decided to establish a scale of assessments for the

regular budget expenditures of UNIDO for the fiscal period 2002-2003 as contained in columns 5 and 6 (that is 22 per cent maximum assessment rate) of the annex to document IDB.24/5.

3. The latest available United Nations scale is the scale of assessments adopted on 22 December 2006, in General Assembly resolution 61/237, for a three-year period 2007-2009. The scale was adjusted to the membership of UNIDO in accordance with General Conference decision GC.12/Dec.9 on the scale of assessments for 2008-2009. Therefore, the scale of assessments (document IDB.33/3) currently in use by UNIDO for 2008-2009 is only slightly changed in 2010-2011 due to the accession of Samoa as a new Member State to UNIDO on 11 December 2008, as shown in the attached annex.

4. Should an updated United Nations scale for the period 2010-2011 be adopted by the General Assembly prior to reaching a decision at the 13th session of the General Conference in December 2009, and in line with past practice, the Secretariat will issue a revised document accordingly.

II. Action required of the Committee

5. The Committee may wish to propose to the Industrial Development Board the adoption of the following draft decision:

“The Industrial Development Board:

“(a) Takes note of document IDB.36/3-PBC.25/3;

“(b) Recommends to the General Conference the establishment of a scale of assessments for the regular budget expenditures of UNIDO for the fiscal period 2010-2011, based on the United Nations General Assembly resolution 61/237, adjusted to the membership of UNIDO on the understanding that new Members shall be assessed for the year in which they become Members on the basis of the United Nations scale of assessments, as applicable to UNIDO”.
