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I. Overview

1. The financial situation as at 30 September 2009 can be summarized in the following major points:
 - (a) The overall implementation rate of 76.2 per cent of the regular budget reflects a higher level than that of the previous biennium (75.8 per cent). The rate is expected to increase to about 92 per cent by the end of the biennium;
 - (b) The operational budget is estimated to remain financially sound with the possibility of an increase in the reserve;
 - (c) The expenditure level for buildings management amounted to €35.6 million, compared to €31.9 million for the same period of the previous biennium;
 - (d) The level of regular budget cash resources (including the Working Capital Fund) was €65.6 million. In comparison, the cash balance as at 30 September 2008 and 2007 was €66.1 million and €49.3 million, respectively;
 - (e) The collection rate of 2009 assessed contributions was 86.1 per cent, compared to the 2008 and 2007 rates of 90.7 per cent and 69.1 per cent, respectively. However, on 2 October 2009 the current year's collection rate improved to 89.8 per cent upon receipt of additional contributions;
 - (f) The collection rate of prior years' arrears, as compared to the current year's assessment, was 4.1 per cent, compared to 2008 and 2007 rates of 3.8 per cent and 6.6 per cent, respectively;
 - (g) Outstanding contributions amounted to €122.6 million, as shown in the annex to the present document (including arrears of €69.1 million by the United States of America, and €2.1 million by the former Yugoslavia). However, as mentioned under (e) above, on 2 October 2009, the amount was reduced to €119.7 million. The outstanding amounts as at 30 September 2008 and 2007 were €127.1 million and €137.3 million, respectively;
 - (h) The Working Capital Fund was at the level of €7,423,030. However, an amount of €16,448 was outstanding as at 30 September 2009;
 - (i) A provisional amount of €9,560,622 from the unencumbered balances of appropriations was received during the period 1 November 2008 to 30 September 2009, and interest income in excess of budgetary estimates of €2,414,832 totalling €11,975,454;
 - (j) A conference room paper will provide information on the current status of assessed contributions and voting rights, updated to 30 November 2009.

II. Regular and operational budgets (January 2008 to September 2009)

2. The regular budget status shows an overall implementation rate of 76.2 per cent of gross budgeted expenditures and reflects a higher level than that of the same period of the preceding biennium (75.8 per cent). The rate of implementation is

expected to increase to about 92 per cent during the final quarter of the biennium due to accelerated implementation of programmes and is expected to match the collection rate of assessed contributions during the biennium. Further payments and other budgetary expenditures relating to Conference Services and Common Services will be incurred before the end of the year in connection with the convening of the thirteenth session of the General Conference.

3. Operational budget expenditures were maintained through a higher-than-budgeted vacancy factor. The reserve level thus increased from €6.5 million on 1 January 2008 to €8.0 million as of 30 September 2009. It is expected, however, that the level of the reserve at the end of the biennium will be lower depending upon the actual income and expenditure in the final months of the year.

4. The Buildings Management Service budget has been implemented according to the workplan. Expenditures for 2008-2009 as at 30 September 2009 amounted to €35.6 million, compared to €31.9 million for the same period of the previous biennium.

III. Assessed contributions

A. Collections

5. A total of 81 Member States, including 11 least developed countries (LDCs), have made full payments and 25 Member States, five of which are LDCs, have made partial payments and/or their adjustments have been credited towards their assessed contributions for the year 2009. Collections in the current year, up to September 2009, broken down by List of States, are shown in table 1.

6. The detailed status of assessed contributions outstanding as at 30 September 2009 is contained in the annex to the present document. The scale of assessment and

outstanding contributions as of the same period, broken down by List of States, are shown in table 2.

IV. Voting rights

7. As indicated in the annex to the present document, the voting rights of 38 Member States had been suspended as at 30 September 2009, in accordance with Article 5.2 of the Constitution and financial regulation 5.5 (b), as shown in table 3.

8. In order to restore their voting rights for 2009, these Member States must pay their full contributions for 2006 and prior years, including advances to the Working Capital Fund, as well as a partial contribution for 2007. The minimum total amount that would have to be paid by these Member States is €28,431,440.

V. Multi-year payment plans

9. Table 4 shows, in summary form, the current status of those Member States that have entered into payment plan arrangements to settle their respective outstanding assessed contributions. The Secretariat notes with appreciation that, since the issuance of document GC.12/6, Afghanistan has successfully completed payments under its plan and has settled all its outstanding assessed contributions.

The Secretariat has further noted with appreciation that, as shown in table 4, all other Member States, except one, have fully met their obligations as stipulated in their multi-year payment plans. The Secretariat recognizes the considerable efforts made by those Member States to honour the commitments that they had made when they submitted their plans.

10. The Secretariat concludes that the system of multi-year payment plans, as introduced and recommended by the open-ended discussion group on timely payment of assessed contributions in 1998 (IDB.19/12 and IDB.19/Dec.5), has made a positive contribution in encouraging and assisting Member States to reduce their unpaid assessed contributions and in providing a way for them to demonstrate their commitment to meeting their financial obligations to UNIDO. Other Member States in arrears are encouraged to consider submitting payment plans to steadily reduce their outstanding assessed contributions.

Arrears by former Member States

11. The amounts owed to UNIDO by the United States of America are as follows:

Assessed contributions (1994-1996)	€69,068,887
Income tax (under the Tax Reimbursement Agreement)	€955,784

Payment of these arrears is being pursued by the Secretariat.

12. Arrears of the former Yugoslavia amount to €2,081,599 (1990-2001). As stated in document IDB.36/5, resolution 63/249, dated 19 March 2009, was adopted by the United Nations General Assembly, regarding the unpaid assessed contributions of the former Yugoslavia.

13. The Secretariat will continue to follow-up on this issue and as soon as the requested information is obtained regarding the respective shares due from the successor States of the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia in line with the above resolution, the governing bodies will be informed accordingly and

appropriate action will be taken by the Secretariat to resolve these outstanding arrears.

VI. Unencumbered balances of appropriations and interest income in excess of budgetary estimates

14. The amount of €1,503,098 from the biennium 1992-1993 and 1996-2005 was collected and distributed to eligible Member States in January 2009.

15. Pursuant to PBC conclusion 2009/3 and decision IDB.36/Dec.12 on unutilized balances of appropriations, the amount of €6,812,043, representing unspent balances of collections for the biennium 2006-2007 was to be returned to the Member States in accordance with the relevant Financial Regulations of UNIDO.

16. In addition, as at 30 September 2009 the unencumbered balances of appropriations relating to prior bienniums provisionally amounted to €9,560,622 and interest income in excess of budgetary estimates amounted to €2,414,832, totalling €11,975,454. The detailed proposal by UNIDO on the utilization of the unencumbered balances of appropriations is provided in a separate document, GC.13/8.

VII. Action required of the Conference

17. The General Conference may wish to consider adopting the following draft decision:

“The General Conference:

“(a) Takes note of the information provided in document GC.13/12;

“(b) Urges those Member States and former Member States that have not yet paid their assessed contributions, including advances to the Working Capital Fund and prior years’ arrears, to do so without delay;

“(c) Requests the Director-General to pursue his efforts and contacts with Member States to effect the collection of arrears.”
