## REPORT OF THE PROGRAMME AND BUDGET COMMITTEE

#### Addendum

1. On 9 December 1985, at the request of the General Conference, the Programme and Budget Committee met to consider the financial implications resulting from consultations between the Secretary-General of the United Nations and the Director-General of UNIDO (UNIDO/IDB.1/26/Add.1/Rev.1) and the revised proposals of the Director-General (UNIDO/PBC.1/CRP.9); it reached the following conclusions, which are brought to the attention of the Board:

## A. Provisions for communications

### Conclusion 85/11

The proposal by the Director-General for an additional allocation for communications to the amount of \$120,000 (para.6 of document UNIDO/PBC.1/CRP.9) was voted upon and failed to receive the required majority. The results of the vote were: 14 in favour, 10 against and one abstention.

# B. Revisions in the regular budget 1986-1987

2. Having considered a draft conclusion submitted by the Director-General (UNIDO/PBC.1/L.9), by 15 votes to 6 and 4 abstentions, the Committee adopted the recommendations contained in the conclusion 1985/12 below.

### Conclusion 1985/12

The Committee recommended to the Board that it submit to the Conference for adoption a draft decision approving the following revisions in the regular budget for the biennium 1986-1987:
