I. Overview

1. The financial situation as at 31 March 2011 can be summarized in the following major points:

(a) Regular budget net expenditure for the first year of the biennium 2010-2011 amounted to €70.8 million in 2010, or 92.1 per cent of the approved 2010 net budget estimates. As at 31 March 2011, €93.3 million or 57.6 per cent of the gross biennial appropriation was spent;

(b) The operational budget expenditure amounted to €12.0 million in the reporting period. Support costs and other income amounted to €12.4 million at the end of 2010 and €4.9 million in the first quarter of 2011;

(c) The expenditure level for buildings management amounted to €32.6 million in accordance with the prevailing workplan;

(d) The level of regular budget cash resources (including the Working Capital Fund) was €55.2 million. In comparison, the cash balance as at 31 March 2010 and 2009 was €74.7 million and €75.0 million, respectively; the noteworthy difference is due to the fact that significant contributions have not yet been received by the end of March 2011;

(e) The collection rate of 2011 assessed contributions at 31 March was 26.4 per cent, compared to the 2010 and 2009 rates of 52.3 and 47.3 per cent, respectively. However, on 1 April 2011 the current year's collection rate improved to 35.01 per cent upon receipt of additional contributions;

(f) The collection rate of prior years' arrears, as compared to the current year's assessments, was 1 per cent. The rates as at 31 March 2010 and 2009, as compared to the assessments of those years, were 1 and 0.3 per cent, respectively;

(g) Outstanding assessed contributions amounted to €170.1 million, as shown in the annex to the present document (including arrears of €69.1 million by the United States of America, and €2.1 million by the former Yugoslavia). The outstanding amounts as at 31 March 2010 and 2009 were €152.2 million and €155.5 million, respectively;

(h) The Working Capital Fund was at the level of €7,423,030. However, an amount of €4,737 was outstanding as at 31 March 2011;

(i) A conference room paper on the status of assessed contributions and voting rights, updated to 30 April 2011, will be provided.

II. Regular and operational budgets, 2010-2011

Regular budget

2. Allotments of €77.9 million were issued in 2010 against which, by 31 December 2010, regular budget net expenditures amounted to €70.8 million. This amount corresponds to 92.1 per cent of the total approved net regular budget for 2010. In the first year of the preceding biennium (2008), a lower implementation rate of 85.4 per cent was recorded.

3. At the onset of the second year of the biennium allotments to the value of €79.9 million were issued. This is equivalent to the full rate of the gross expenditure budget for 2011 except for consultancies, expert group meetings and staff member travel. The allotments cover €53.3 million for staff on established posts and €26.6 million for all other expenditure categories.

4. As at 31 March 2011, total regular budget allotments for the biennium amounted to €158.8 million, which represents 98.1 per cent of the gross expenditure budget. Expenditures amounted to €93.3 million, corresponding to 57.6 per cent of the gross budget. These indicators are comparable with those of the previous biennium, by 31 March 2009: €86.6 million expenditures representing 54.2 per cent of the gross budget.

Operational budget

5. Allotments of €11.2 million were issued at the start of 2010. This level is equivalent to 100 per cent of estimates included in the approved programme and budgets for 2010. Additional amounts of €11.6 million were allotted at the beginning of 2011 resulting in a total allotment of €22.8 million.

6. Operational budget expenditures amounted to €12 million on 31 March 2011. In the preceding biennium similar expenditures amounted to €11.4 million as at 31 March 2009.

7. The technical cooperation activities in 2010 reached a historic level of US\$ 153.5 million, including obligations. This surpassed annual deliveries of all years since 1986, except 1990. The income from support costs and other miscellaneous sources in 2010 amounted to €12.4 million. During the first quarter of 2011, technical cooperation project delivery reached US\$ 52.5 million, including unliquidated obligations. The income recorded for this period amounted to €4.9 million.

Buildings management

8. An allotment of €31.8 million for 2010 was issued at the start of the biennium with an additional amount of €32.3 million in 2011. The buildings management budget is being implemented in accordance with the prevailing workplan.

9. Expenditures as at 31 March 2011 amounted to €32.6 million compared to €31.7 million in 2009. This represents 50.8 per cent of the buildings management gross expenditure budget.

III. Assessed contributions

A. Collections

10. A total of 38 Member States, including five least developed countries (LDCs), have made full payments. Sixty-one Member States, eleven of which are LDCs, have made partial payments and/or their adjustments have been credited towards

their assessed contributions for the year 2011. The collections in the period from January to March 2011, broken down by List of States, are shown in table 1.

B. Outstanding contributions

11. The detailed status of assessed contributions outstanding as at 31 March 2011 is contained in the annex to the present document. The scale of assessment and outstanding contributions as of the same period, broken down by List of States, are shown in table 2.

IV. Voting rights

12. As indicated in the annex to the present document, the voting rights of 39 Member States had been suspended as at 31 March 2011, in accordance with Article 5.2 of the Constitution and financial regulation 5.5 (b). In comparison, the

voting rights of 47 countries had been suspended at the same time last year. The status of voting rights in respect of the various policymaking organs is shown in table 3.

13. In order to restore their voting rights for 2011, these Member States must pay their full contributions for 2008 and prior years, including advances to the Working Capital Fund, as well as a partial contribution for 2009. The minimum total amount that would have to be paid by these Member States is €31,807,505.

V. Multi-year payment plans

14. Table 4 shows, in summary form, the current status of those Member States that have entered into payment plan arrangements to settle outstanding assessed contributions. The Secretariat notes with appreciation and recognizes the considerable efforts made by all those Member States that have honoured their commitments and obligations as stipulated in their respective payment plans. Other Member States in arrears are encouraged to consider submitting payment plans to steadily reduce their outstanding assessed contributions.

VI. Arrears by former Member States

15. The amount of arrears owed to UNIDO by the United States of America is €69,068,887 (1994-1996) while the arrears of the former Yugoslavia amount to €2,081,599 (1990-2001). Payment of these arrears is being pursued by the Secretariat.

VII. Unutilized balances of appropriations and interest income in excess of budgetary estimates

16. Detailed information on the unutilized balances of appropriations is provided separately in document IDB.39/12-PBC.27/12.

VIII. Action required of the Committee

17. The Committee may wish to consider recommending to the Board the adoption of the following draft decision:

“The Industrial Development Board:

“(a) Takes note of the information provided in document IDB.39/14-PBC.27/14;

“(b) Urges those Member States and former Member States that have not yet paid their assessed contributions, including advances to the Working Capital Fund and prior years’ arrears, to do so without delay;

“(c) Requests the Director-General to pursue his efforts and contacts with Member States and former Member States to effect the collection of arrears.”
