1st plenary meeting

Item 1: Opening of the fourteenth session

The Conference was opened by the outgoing President, H.E. Mr. Ali Asghar Soltanieh, (Islamic Republic of Iran).

International Day of Solidarity with the Palestinian People



Cybercafé


A cybercafé will be available on the ground floor of the M-building with desktop computers connected to the internet.
