We will step up the strategic consultation function of this organization, and do our best in providing policy guidance, technical and experience sharing, and comprehensive solution to member states. This organization will vigorously promote sustainable industrial development, and play a prominent role in industrial upgrading.
- 3. Strengthen and expand partnerships. We must forge closer and stronger ties with other UN development agencies,

global and regional financial institutions, multilateral foundations, private sector and civil society. To complement traditional North-South cooperation, we shall promote the South-South and the Triangular cooperation.

- 4. Enhance the efficiency and cost-effectiveness. The structure of UNIDO shall be optimized. The connection and collaboration between the headquarters and field offices need be strengthened to boost the efficiency of organizational operation and program execution.
- 5. Motivate the staff to their full potential. I feel privileged to lead the excellent staff team of UNIDO. You are the most valuable assets of UNIDO. As the DG, I will create an enabling environment for your career development, emphasize merit-based promotion and ensure all of you can achieve your full potential at UNIDO. After all, UNIDO is as good as you.

Ladies and gentlemen,

The world is changing, UNIDO is also changing. We must be adaptive, responsive, innovative and effective. The time has come, hope and chances are with us. We have no choice but to answer the call of hope, we have no choice but to make UNIDO the best it can be. UNIDO is now embarking on a new journey, and of course, the path towards the attainment of its vision will

be long and sometimes difficult. However, as the Chinese ancient philosopher Lao Tzu remarked, "A thousand-mile journey starts with a single step". Aiming high, looking far, we must have confidence, we must move forward. We shall translate the commitment of Member States and dedication of staff into concrete actions.
