Dirk Niebel

Federal Minister of Economic Cooperation and Development, Germany

Yumkella took up his current position on 29 June 2013, after serving for 8 years as the Director General of UNIDO. Since June 2009 he also acts as Chairman of UN Energy. Among his many public roles, he served as Minister for Trade, Industry and State Enterprises of Sierra Leone from 1994 to 1995.

Permanent Representative of Benin to the United Nations

Until his appointment as Ambassador of Benin to the UN in January 2010, Zinsou held the position of the Chargé d'Affaires ad interim. He has served as Minister Counsellor as well as the Head of the Foreign Ministry's Division responsible for Universal Political Organizations and International Non-governmental Organizations.
