Preparations for the sixteenth session of the General Conference

Report by the Director General

The present report provides general information on the organization of the work of the sixteenth session of the General Conference, including items proposed for inclusion in the provisional agenda.


I. Introduction

1. The General Conference of UNIDO is the principal organ of the Organization, consisting of representatives of all Members (Articles 7.1 and 8.1 of the Constitution). The main functions of the Conference are stipulated in Article 8.3 of the Constitution. In particular, the Conference should determine the guiding principles and the policies of the Organization. Unless it decides otherwise, the Conference is to hold a regular session every two years, at the seat of the Organization (Article 8.2). The last regular session (fifteenth) of the Conference was held in Lima, Peru, from 2 to 6 December 2013.

For reasons of economy, this document has been printed in a limited number. Delegates are kindly requested to bring their copies of documents to meetings.

II. Background information

A. Date and place of the Conference

2. In line with General Conference decision GC.15/Dec.20, the sixteenth session of the General Conference will be held in Vienna from 30 November to 4 December 2015. It is planned that the meetings of the General Conference will take place in the C-building of the Vienna International Centre.

B. Budgetary matters

- 3. The Organization's resources available for holding the sixteenth session of the Conference, as provided for in the programme and budgets of UNIDO, 2014-2015, total €826,700. The budget of the Conference is based on the following assumptions:
- (a) The session will last five working days providing for 10 plenary meetings as well as meetings of the main committee and geographical groups;
- (b) Interpretation for plenary and main committee meetings and documentation will be provided in six languages (Arabic, Chinese, English, French, Russian and Spanish);
- (c) As per Board decision IDB.41/Dec.12 (l), with the suspension of rule 65 of the rules of procedures, summary records will not be provided for the sixteenth session of the Conference.

C. Agenda

- 4. In accordance with Article 9.4 (g) of the Constitution, the Board prepares the provisional agenda for each session of the General Conference. Rule 13 of the rules of procedure of the Conference provides guidelines for the contents of the provisional agenda of a regular session of the Conference. Furthermore, in accordance with rule 12, the Board shall prepare that provisional agenda on the basis of a list of items proposed for inclusion as submitted by the Director General.
- 5. Annotations indicating briefly the history of each item, the proposed documentation, the substance of the matter to be discussed and earlier relevant decisions by the Conference or other organs of the Organization will be issued following the forty-third session of the Board.
- 6. A list of items proposed for inclusion in the provisional agenda for the sixteenth session of the Conference is contained in annex I to the present document, together with an indication of relevant mandates for the items. A provisional schedule of work is contained in annex II to the present document.

D. Documentation

7. In accordance with rule 23 of the rules of procedure of the Conference, documents required for consideration of items on the provisional agenda will be

distributed by the Director General in all languages of the Conference to all recipients of the provisional agenda not later than forty-five days before the opening date of the session.

III. Organization of the work of the Conference

- 8. In keeping with practice of previous sessions of the General Conference, an overarching theme has been developed for the sixteenth session "Sustainable industrialization for shared prosperity".
- 9. As encouraged by the Conference in resolution GC.9/Res.1, a forum on industrial development issues is foreseen. At the sixteenth session, it is planned to integrate the Forum on inclusive and sustainable industrial development (ISID), as well as the UNIDO donor meeting. The ISID Forum and the donor meeting will take place during plenary meetings to provide an opportunity for high-level participants to communicate their views on selected topics, thereby allowing for a thematic and interregional debate (annex II, proposed schedule of work). In line with resolution GC.9/Res.1, it is suggested that the two events be included in the provisional agenda of the session (annex I, item 9).
- 10. With a view to enhancing the debate on critical issues, it is proposed to introduce a speaking limit during the general debate of five minutes for Member States and ten minutes for regional groups.
- 11. At its previous sessions, the Conference established a main committee to which it allocated a number of agenda items. The Board may wish to recommend to the Conference a similar procedure for its sixteenth session, keeping in mind that the possibility of creating additional committees is constrained by the limited resources available (see para. 3 above). Items 7 to 19 of the proposed draft agenda would thus be referred to the main committee for a more focused debate aimed at the preparation of consensus draft decisions and resolutions for submission to the plenary.
- 12. The work of the previous sessions was also facilitated by setting up, under the guidance of the President of the Board, informal consultations for the preparation of the Conference. Such an informal group, composed of representatives of permanent missions to UNIDO in Vienna, has met prior to previous sessions of the Conference and has prepared a report to the Conference containing recommendations that cover most of the items on the agenda as well as organizational matters.
- 13. Taking into consideration past experience, the Board may wish to suggest the early commencement of informal consultations chaired by the President of the Board. To facilitate the work of the informal consultations in advance of the General Conference, it is strongly recommended to adopt the successful approach of other organizations in establishing a deadline for the submission of draft decisions and resolutions of three weeks prior to the Conference.

IV. Action required of the Board

14. The Board may wish to consider adopting the following draft decision:

"The Industrial Development Board:

- "(a) Takes note of the information provided in document IDB.43/13;
- (b) Adopts the following agenda for the sixteenth session of the General Conference:

- (c) Agrees to hold a forum on industrial development issues within the framework of the General Conference (provisional agenda, item 9);
- (d) Recommends to the Conference that items 7 to 19 of the provisional agenda be allocated to a main committee of the Conference;
- (e) Recommends that, in the light of experience gained in the preparation of previous sessions of the Conference, the President of the forty-third session of the Industrial Development Board conduct informal consultations for the preparation of the sixteenth session of the Conference;
- (f) Urges Member States to submit to the informal consultations any proposed draft decisions or resolutions by 6 November 2015."
